On Jordan's bank the Baptist's cry Announces that the Lord is nigh Awake and hearken for he brings Glad tidings of the King of Kings


Then cleansed be ev'ry heart from sin Make straight the way for God within And let each heart prepare a home Where such a mighty guest may come
